PROCESS FOR MEMBERSHIP

The Associate member* will need to attend three consecutive monthly meetings. These meetings are usually held the first Sunday of each month. In addition, the Associate member must attend an orientation in which an official FJA member will explain the way the FJA works. Specific tasks will be assigned in order to become an official member. You must be involved with the committees and with the organization of the programs that are presented in our different churches. You will only exercise the right of voice as an Associate member. You will not receive FJA discounts until officially initiated, unless otherwise considered by the FJA Administration. Upon completion of all components the FJA Administration will consider the application submitted and an induction will be held; therefore, granting Official membership on the fourth consecutive meeting attended.

* Associate member is a person being processed for Official Membership of FJA

CODE OF ETHICS

Members of the *Federación de Jóvenes Adventistas* shall uphold and advance the integrity, honor and dignity of FJA by: being honest, impartial, and serving with fidelity our organization, our Youth, and most importantly our God; striving to increase the development of the Seventh Day Adventist Youth Community. They shall use their knowledge and skills for the advancement of the Seventh Day Adventist Youth Community to achieve educational excellence, unity, and spiritual enhancement. To achieve these goals, all members shall:

1. Act in a professional manner maintaining integrity and truthfulness and avoiding conflicts of interest.
2. Respect and protect the privacy, rights and dignity of others and maintain confidentiality when required.
3. Issue statements or present information only in an objective and truthful manner.
4. Treat fairly all officers and co-members, recognizing their unique contributions and capabilities.
5. Present a professional and Christ-like image in dress as well as behavior at all FJA functions and while wearing the FJA name and/or logo.
6. Call attention to unprofessional, unethical or inappropriate behavior and notify the appropriate leadership or authority if such behavior continues or threatens the safety or welfare of others.
7. Accept responsibility for their actions and recognize the contributions of others; seek critical review of their work and offer objective criticism of the work of others.
8. Continue their spiritual and leadership development throughout their time of participation, and provide opportunities for the spiritual and leadership development of those that follow them.
9. Be fiscally responsible with FJA funds by truly attempting to spend within approved budgets and following financial guidelines set by the FJA administration, as appropriate.
10. Abide by the Constitution, policies, procedures and guidelines as established by FJA.
